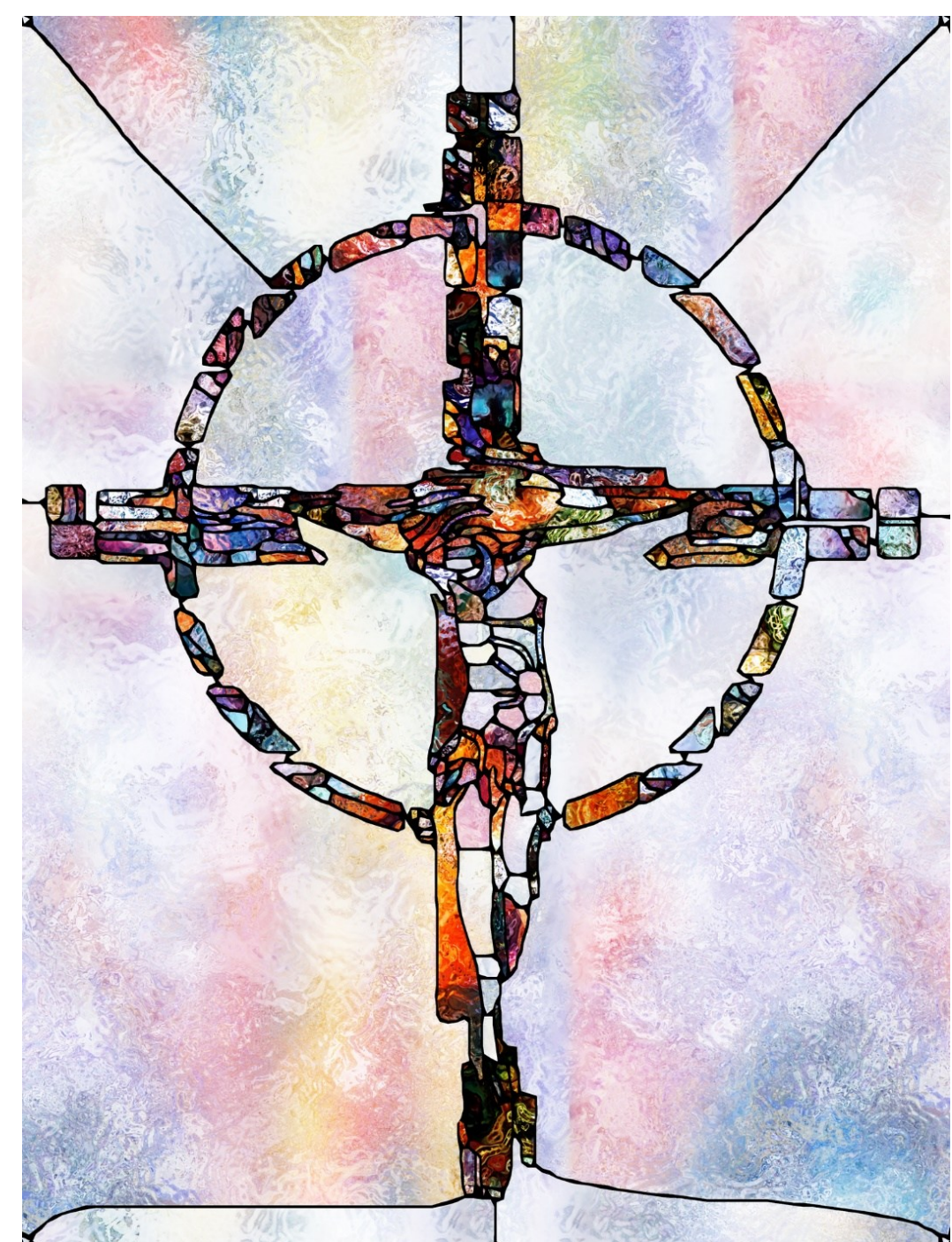

RENEW Question for Sharing

"He was in such agony and he prayed so fervently that his sweat became like drops of blood falling on the ground." Luke 22:44
