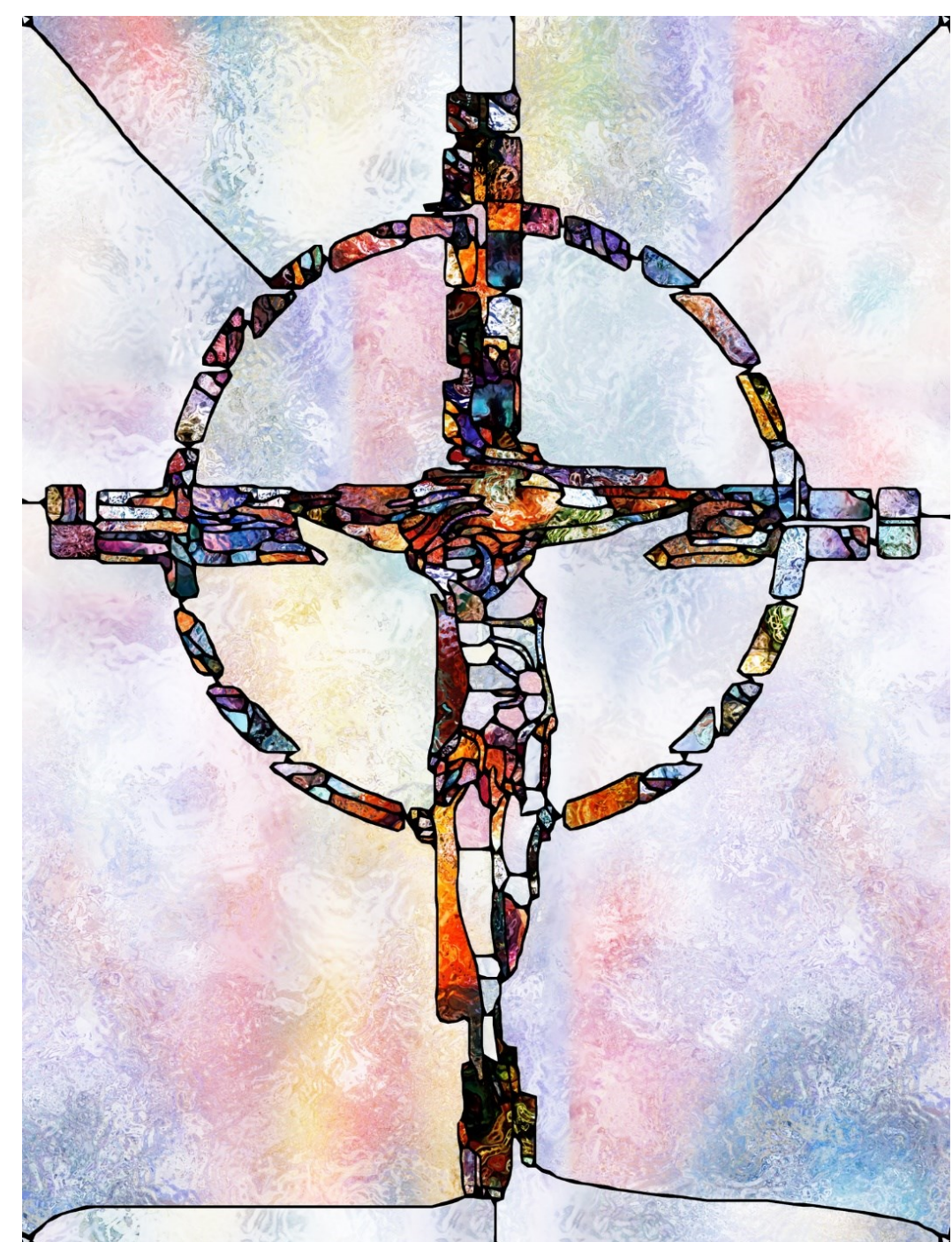
Wedding / Matrimonios
