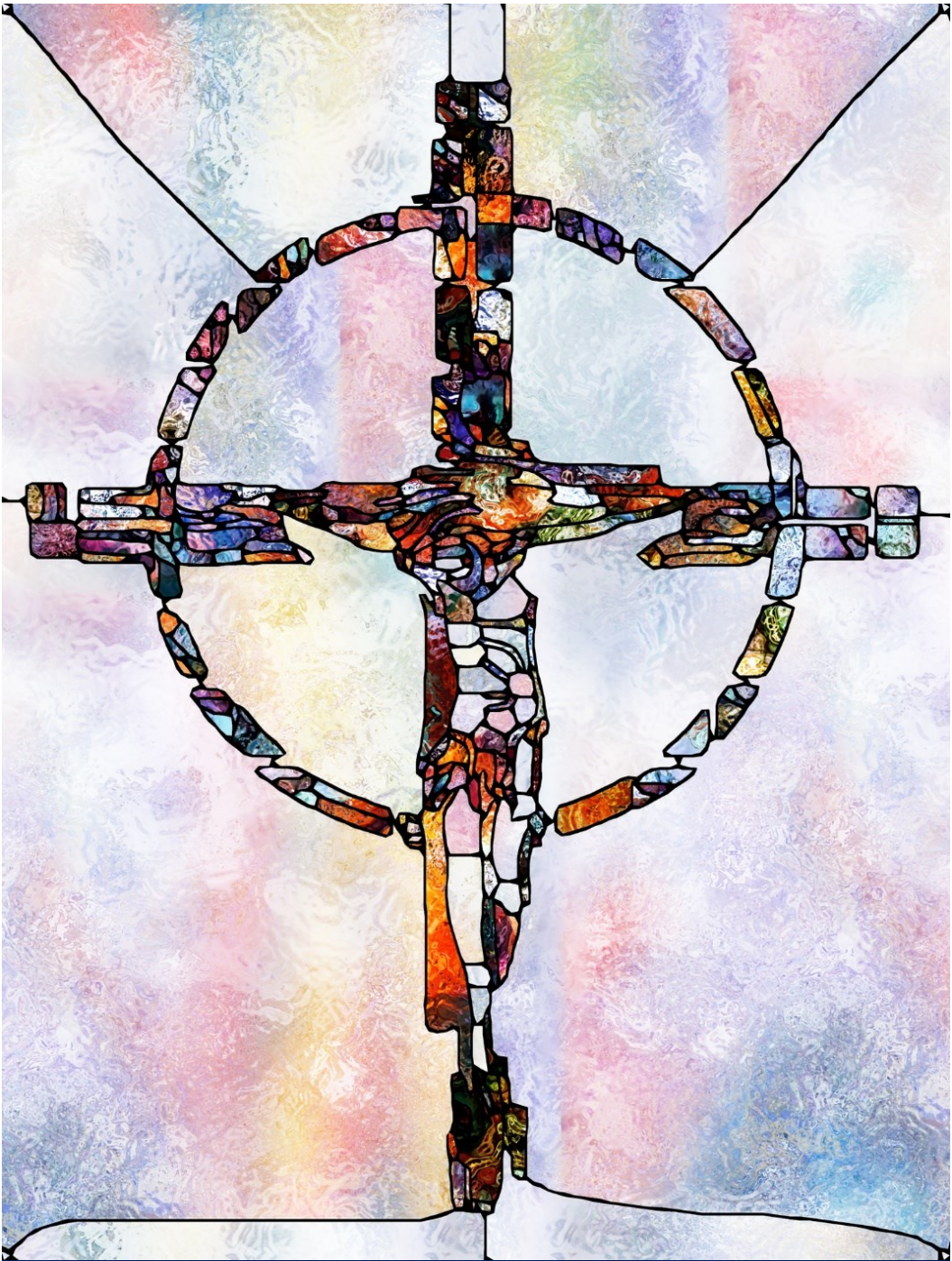
Wedding / Matrimonios

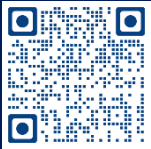
