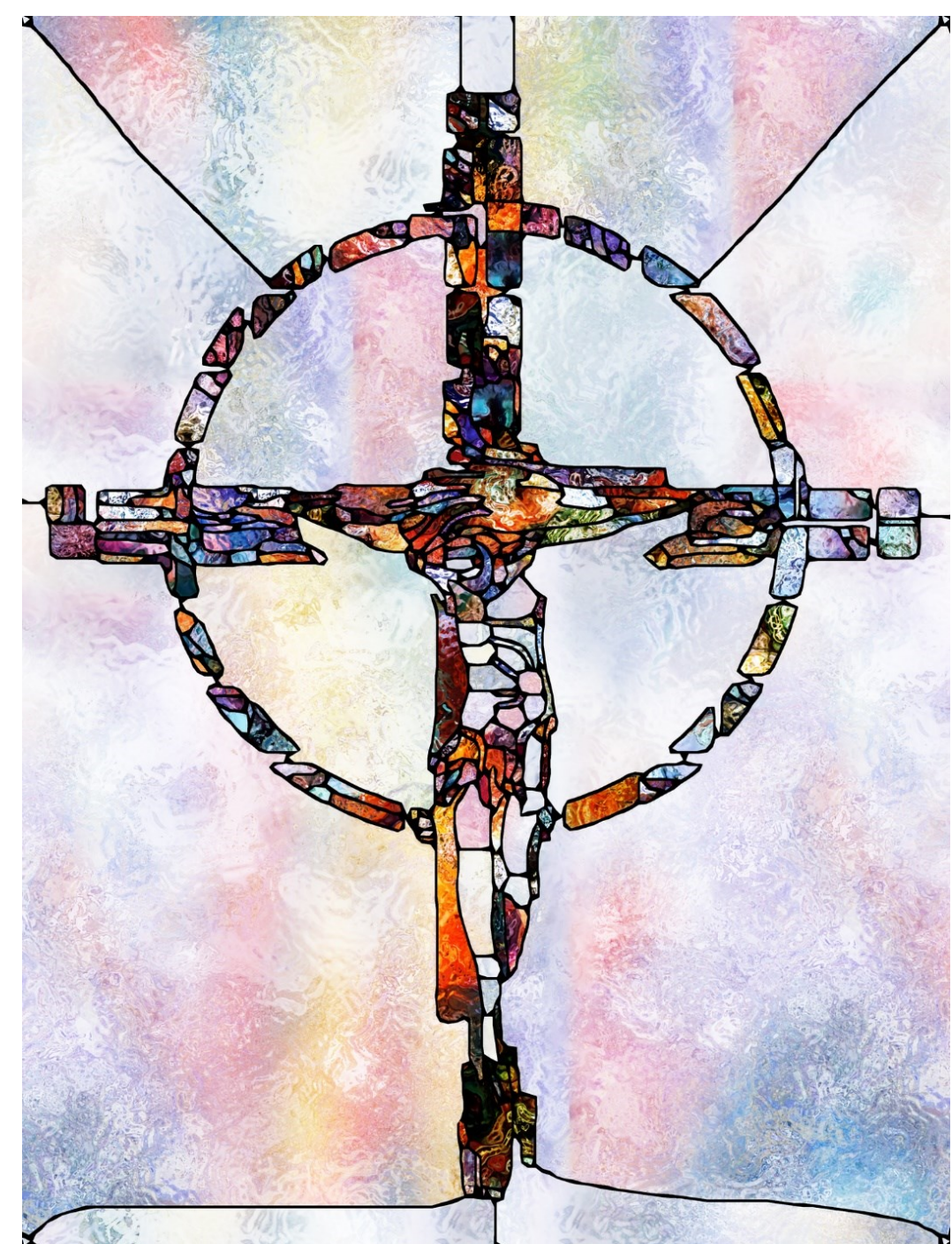
Wedding / Matrimonios

World Day of Prayer for Vocations

World Day of Prayer for Vocations will be observed on Sunday, April 30, 2023, also known as "Good Shepherd Sunday." The purpose of this day is to publicly fulfill the Lord's instruction to "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest" (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2). Please pray that young men and women hear and respond generously to the Lord's call to the priesthood, diaconate, religious life, societies of apostolic life or secular institutes.

RENEW Question for Sharing

While the focus of our readings this Sunday are Jesus' Passion, they also share the actions of a few stewards who accompany Jesus in the story: the man who shared his home for the Passover meal, Simon the Cyrenian who carried the cross, Joseph of Arimathea who shared his tomb and gave Jesus a proper burial, and the "two Marys" who sat at the tomb in prayerful and hopeful vigil. Each gave of themselves for our Lord, allowing their gifts to be offered in service to His son.

We invite you to start planning for Easter Triduum! Our celebration begins on Holy Thursday (April 6) with the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 P.M. Triduum continues with Good Friday (April 7) at 3:00 P.M. (English) or 7:00 P.M. (Spanish). Triduum culminates in the bilingual Easter Vigil Mass (April 8), the liturgy of all liturgies. It begins in the dark, as we gather around the Easter Fire at 8:00 P.M.
