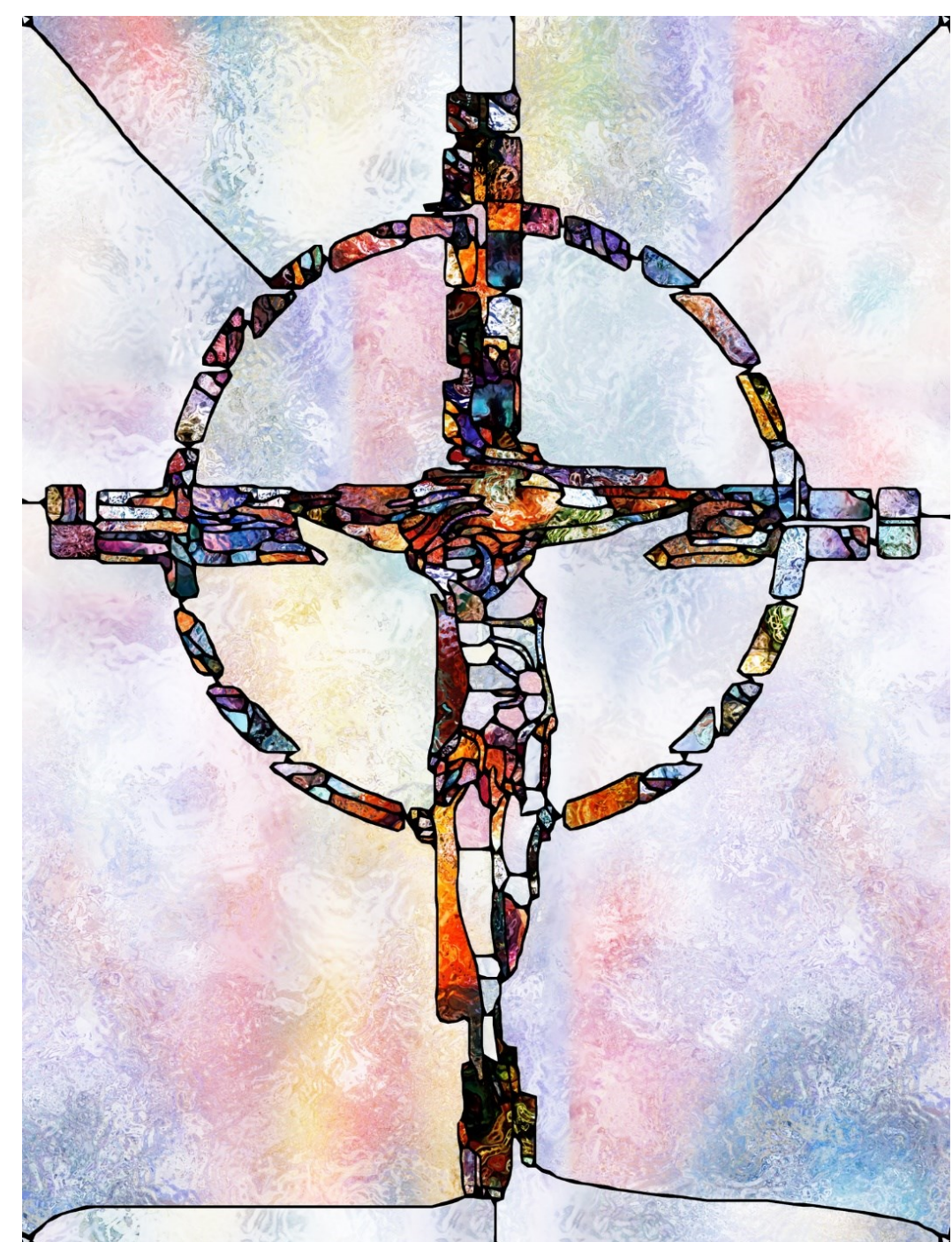
### Wedding / Matrimonios
