

May 8, 2022 – Jesus, our Shepherd; we, His flock

Jesus begins His triumphant entrance into Jerusalem on a *colt*, as prophesied by the Prophet Zechariah. In the First Reading, we find St Paul turning to the Gentiles to deliver the Good News. The Jews only listened for a while, then became jealous, and rejected him. In fact, they became so furious, they incited others against the Apostles until they were all expelled from the city. The Apostles gladly suffered for the Faith, for then they were participating in Christ’s suffering. Meanwhile, the Gentiles eagerly listened to the (*Kerygma*) *preaching of the Good News*.

Though the Apostles were run out of town, a small Christian community was left behind in the Gentiles. We are blessed with St Paul’s letters to the different Gentile communities. He regularly wrote to these new Christians to nourish and encourage them, and now us, in the Faith. u The Responsorial Psalm, like the Gospel, celebrates Jesus as our Good Shepherd, we as His flock. We are not left to struggle through life by our own devices, Jesus sends His Holy Spirit to guide us in our every action. We’re blessed with a loving Shepherd who guides us with kindness and gentleness. His love and goodness are limitless, extending to every time and nation. u In today’s Gospel, Jesus identifies Himself as the Good Shepherd. He proclaims this not on His own authority, but by the Father’s, for He obeys His Father’s will. The Second Reading casts a shadow of the cross on today’s Gospel, for as His sheep we are purchased and made clean by the Blood of the Lamb. So, by the Almighty Father’s power and the shedding of His Son’s blood for us, we sheep belong to the Shepherd and shall not be snatched away.

8 de mayo, 2022 – Jesús, nuestro Pastor; nosotros, Su rebaño

Jesus comienza Su triunfante entrada a Jerusalén montado en *burro* como profetizado por el Profeta Zacarias. En la Primera Lectura, encontramos a San Pablo dirigiéndose a los gentiles para entregar la Buena Nueva. Los Judíos sólo escucharon un momento, luego se llenaron de envidia y le rechazaron. Por hecho, se pusieron tan furiosos, que incitaron a otros en contra de los Apóstoles hasta que todos fueron sacados de la ciudad. Los Apóstoles felizmente sufrieron por la Fe, puesto que así participaban en el sufrimiento de Cristo. Mientras tanto, los gentiles con afán escuchaban al (*Kerygma*) *la predicación de la Buena Nueva*. Aunque los Apóstoles fueron sacados del pueblo, una pequeña comunidad Cristiana se quedó entre los gentiles. Somos bendecidos con las cartas de San Pablo a las diversas comunidades gentiles. Regularmente escribía a estos nuevos Cristianos para nutrir y animarles, y ahora nosotros, en la Fe. u El Salmo Responsorial, como el Evangelio, celebra a Jesús como nuestro Buen Pastor, nosotros como Su rebaño. No se nos deja para batallar en la vida con nuestros propios recursos, Jesús nos envía Su Espíritu Santo para guiarnos en cada una de nuestras acciones. Somo bendecidos con nuestro amoroso Pastor que nos guía con gentileza y ternura. Su amor y bondad no tienen límite y se extienden en cada ocasión y nación. u En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús se identifica como el Buen Pastor. Se proclama no por su propia autoridad, sino por la del Padre, ya que obedece la voluntad de Su Padre. La Segunda Lectura lleva la sombra de la cruz hacia el Evangelio de hoy, porque como sus ovejas, somos comprados y lavados por la Sangre del Cordero. Así que, por el poder del Padre Todopoderoso y el derramar de la Sangre de Su Hijo por nosotros, nosotros las ovejas, pertenecemos al Pastor y no seremos arrebatados de Él.
