Pray Our Parish "Prayer of Renewal"

As our community seeks renewal and transformation – and as we humbly ask God "Why have you put us here? – we will join together in a Prayer for Renewal after communion beginning on Sunday, March 6. We encourage you to make this prayer daily – whether at Mass or at home – and we will have prayer cards for you to take home with you.

Join Our "Novena for Renewal"

A novena is an ancient devotion that consists of nine days of prayer. Our novena will begin at Masses on Sunday, March 6, and continue every day at Mass through Monday, March 13. Each day, we will be invited to reflect on a different theme of renewal.

Listen to Our Daily Meditation

For each of the forty days of Lent, our priests, on our Youtube channel, will share a daily meditation – a few words to stimulate further reflection about this journey of faith we all walk together. We will also share these videos in a daily Lenten email.

Sign Up for a Lenten Pastoral Discussion
