Services will be held at St. Mary's Cemetery as follows:


Sunday, March 9

- Funeral Mass: 10:00 AM


Both the viewing and Funeral Mass will take place at St. Mary's Cemetery. May perpetual light shine upon him, and may he rest in the peace of Christ.
