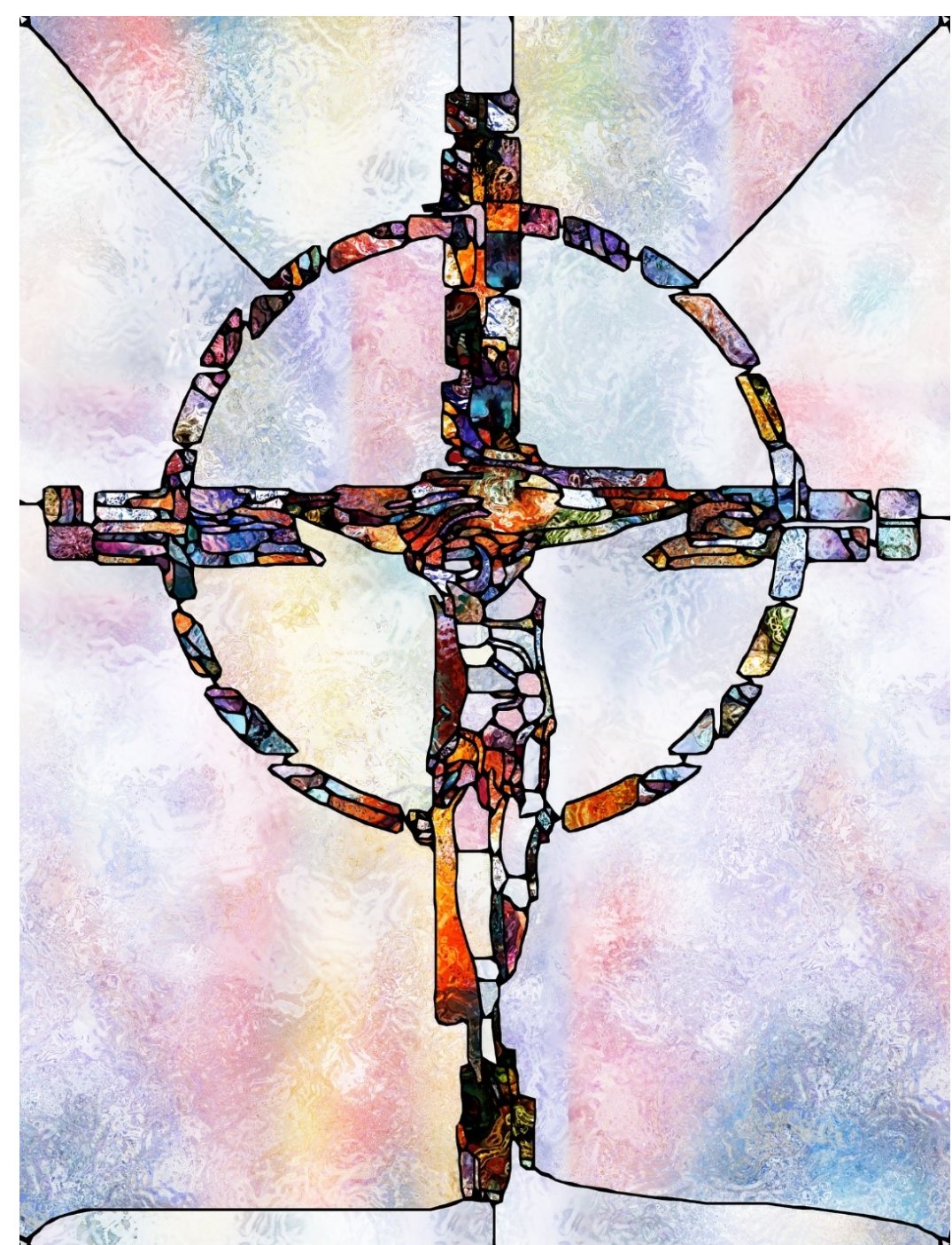

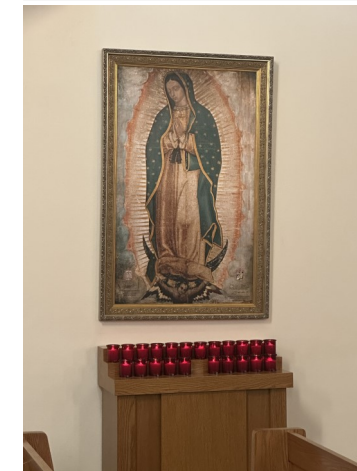
Annual Catholic Appeal

Lighting a Candle for Your Prayer

It is a long loved tradition in our Church to light a candle whenever we offer prayers to God, to our Blessed Mother Mary, and to the saints. The light symbolizes our prayer rising to heaven and our trust in God's loving presence.

How to Light the Candle:

- Drop your offering in the center slot.
- Press your index finger on the button at the base of the candle.
- Hold for a moment until the candle lights.
- Once it glows, take a quiet moment to say your prayer.
