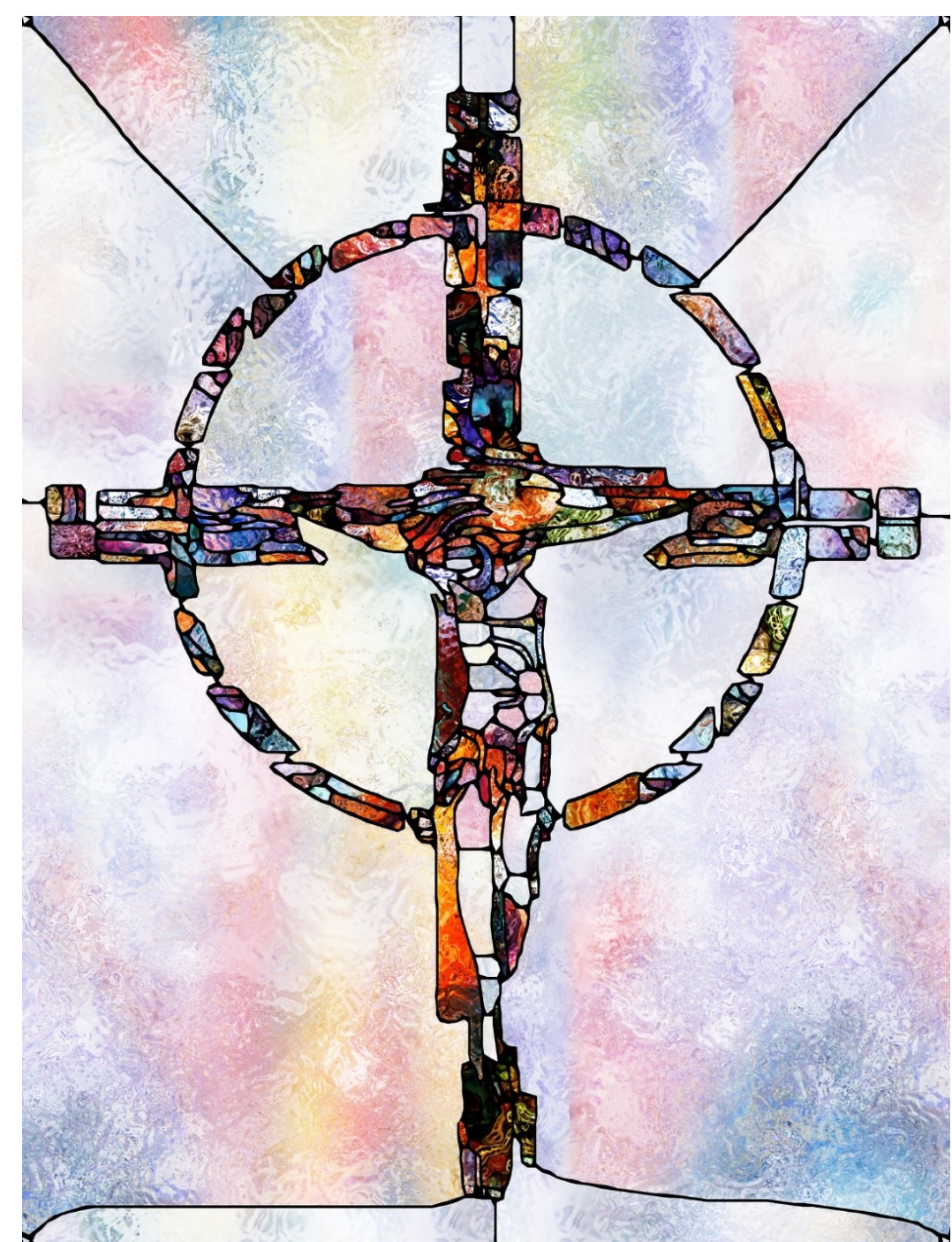
Wedding / Matrimonios

Solidarity with Turkey and Syria
