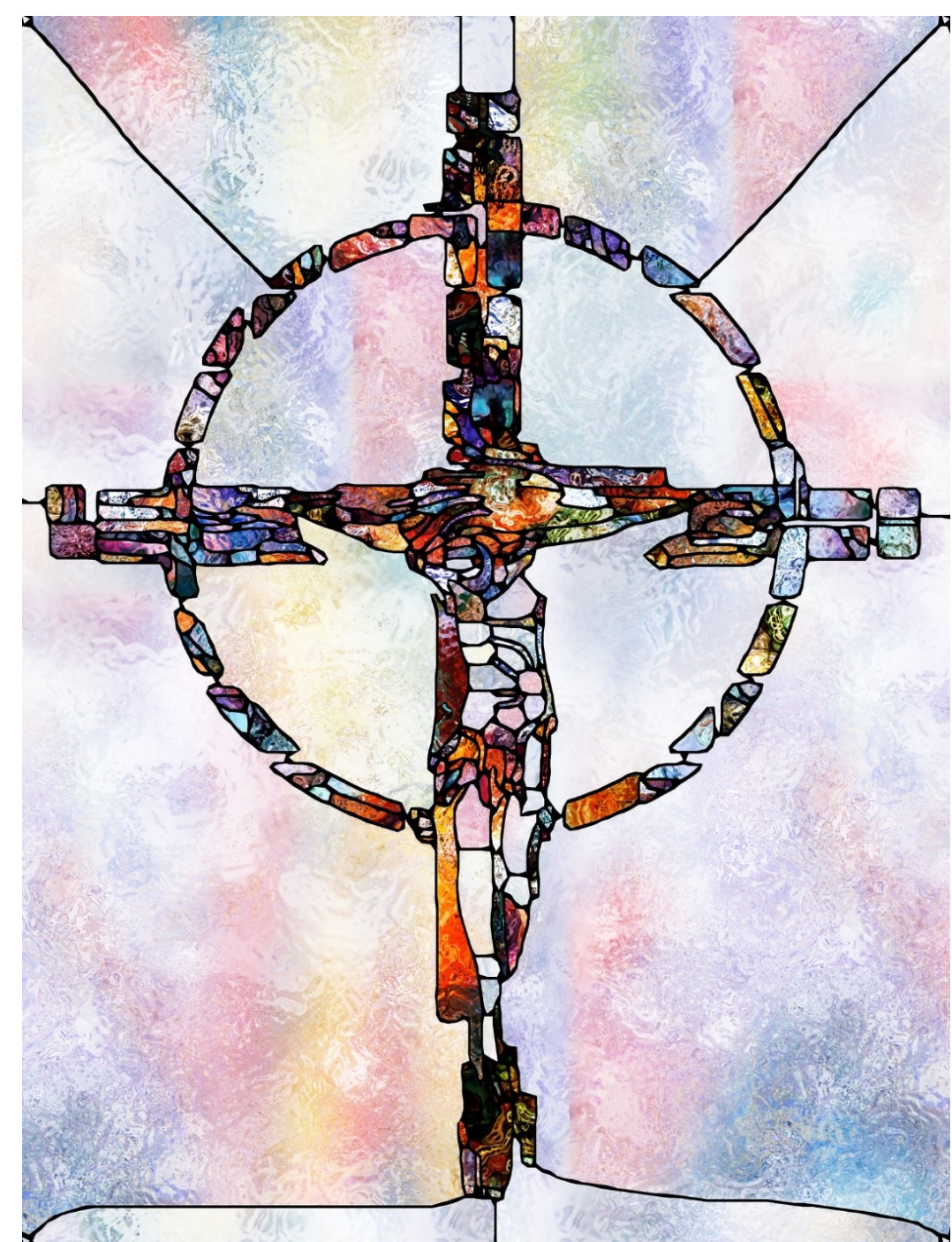
Wedding / Matrimonios

RENEW Question for Sharing

On this fourth Sunday of Easter, we hear the simple message that Jesus is the Good Shepherd and we are His sheep. We are a precious gift the Father has entrusted to Jesus, just as God has entrusted all that is good in our lives to us. Today's readings invite us to reflect inward — they invite us to ask if we truly allow Jesus to shepherd our lives? Do we allow him to lead us along the right path, to guide us and protect us? Or do we try to go it alone, barely stopping to think much if we invite Jesus to be the shepherd of our lives?
