As we begin the holy season of Lent, we are invited to return to the Lord with all our hearts. This sacred time calls us to prayer, fasting, and renewal—a season of grace, healing, and deeper faith. Please join us as we journey together as a parish family: Fasting and Abstinence will be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, with abstinence from meat on all Fridays of Lent. Stations of the Cross will be prayed each Friday during Lent at 6:00 PM in English and 7:00 PM in Spanish. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will take place on Thursdays from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM and on Wednesdays in Spanish at 6:30 PM.


Retiro de Cuaresma
